By submitting his abstract, the author allows the IFODS to publish and distribute or sell his abstract as part of the Abstract Book, which may be distributed on paper.
- All selected **abstracts** will be published in the abstract book. Papers accepted for IPOSTER presentation will be displayed during poster sessions.
- Acceptance or rejection of the paper by the Scientific Committee will be notified by email to the main author (presenter) by April 26th, 2019
- Only persons whose registration is complete will be able to present their **abstracts**
- IPOSTERS will be awarded or encouraged: a special jury will select the three best posters and their authors will receive the SOMPS Poster Award and a cheque of 500€ each.

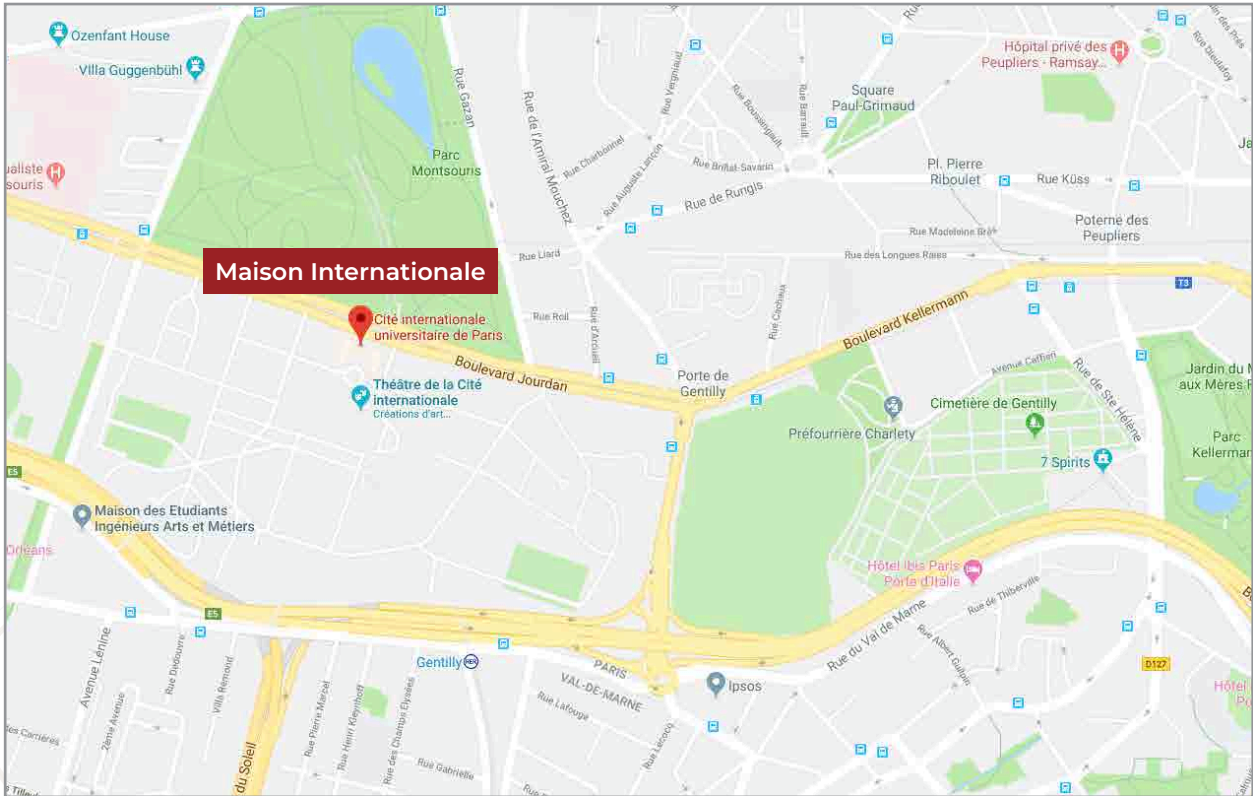
